NEW MODEL OF CARE

stated that the new model of care proposed by Children's Health Queensland would aim to

"include both inpatient and community care options" and that "the Expert Clinical Reference Group formed to oversee this project recommended the following options (all of which are currently being explored):

- ***Tier 1: Community Child and Youth Mental Health Services (CYMHS) and e-CYMHS***
- ***Tier 2a: Adolescent day program/s and assertive community treatment services***
- ***Tier 2b: Adolescent residential rehabilitation unit/s and step up/step down unit/s***
- ***Tier 3: A Statewide adolescent subacute bed-based unit***

The specific details and location of these service options are yet to be finalised. CHQ is also working with the Department of Education Training and Employment to ensure the important educational programs that align with the above model of care are made available to young people."
